

Social media rules and guidelines for library

Updated Dec. 2023

The Great Falls library encourages users to submit comments. once comments are posted, the library reserves the right, but does not assume the obligation to remove user-generated posts. removal criteria includes, but is not limited to content which:

Contains obscene, lewd, offensive, profane, or sexually explicit content

Contains confidential or sensitive personal information

Incites violence or illegal activities

Contains information that reasonably could compromise individual or public safety

Consists solely of commercial advertising

Promotes or endorses political campaigns or candidates

infringes upon intellectual property, copyright or trademark rights of others

Includes spam or links to other sites which violate any Library guidelines

Violates federal, state or local laws

Is requested for removal by subject of the post

Is off subject or out of context (includes name calling or bullying)

If a comment goes against any of these guidelines put into place by the City of Great Falls, it will be hidden and a message will be sent to the user explaining why. If one user leaves a second comment that goes against these rules, that too will be hidden with another warning and a warning that if a third comment is found by said user, they will be blocked from commenting on all posts made by the library on all its social media accounts. If they do indeed leave a third comment that goes against these rules, said user, and any alt accounts from said user, will be blocked from commenting on the Library social media accounts for an indefinite amount of time.
