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As an employee of Great Falls Public Library, and as an immune compromised individual, I am in support of the requirement of facemasks when in the library. This step, along with social distancing, repeated daily sanitizing of the library space, and hand washing and sanitizing helps keep me safe while at work and in contact with a large and diverse community of individuals. The wearing of masks reduces the spread of airborne particles that may spread the coronavirus, and is a medically proven and socially considerate step to take during the current pandemic situation. The mask a person wears prevents their particles from spreading as far, a step that protects other individuals around them. Other individuals in turn wear their own masks that protects the others around them. Wearing a mask is for the protection and consideration of others, not just the individual wearing the mask.
